## Has your Governor Proclaimed Feb. 6 Ronald Reagan Day? *States proclaim February 6 "Ronald Reagan Day"*

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Every year the [Ronald Reagan Legacy Project](http://RonaldReaganLegacyProject.org) asks governors from all 50 states to make proclamations declaring February 6 “Ronald Reagan Day”. This year will mark the 100th anniversary of late President Reagan’s birthday. The Ronald Reagan Legacy Project proudly commends the governors -- Republicans and Democrats alike -- who have recognized February 6 as Ronald Reagan Day in their states. Thus far, 21 out of 50 governors have issued proclamations.

**“I urge every governor to issue a proclamation declaring ‘Ronald Reagan Day’ in their state,”** said Grover Norquist, chairman of the RRLP. **“For those states currently without a proclamation, citizens are encouraged to contact their Governor.”**
